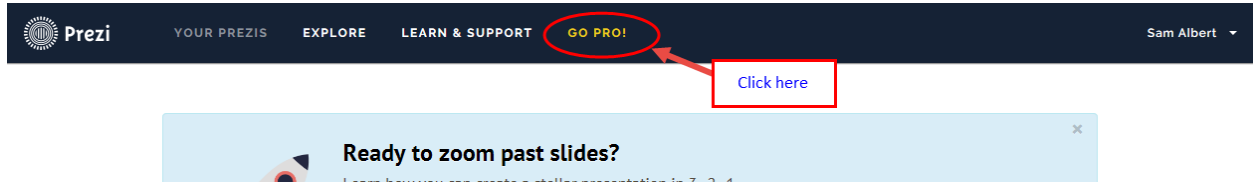
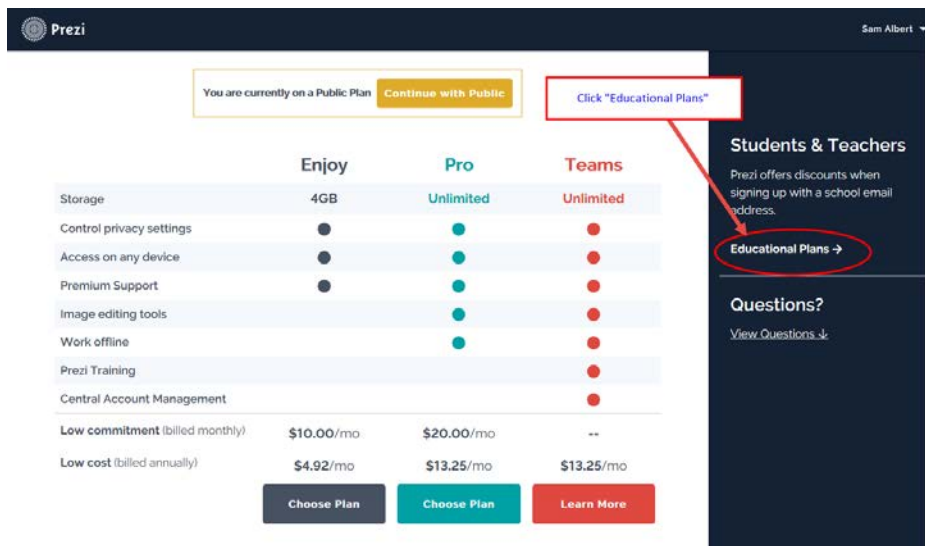


How to Convert your Free Prezi account to a Free Educational Prezi account AND Protect your work!!!

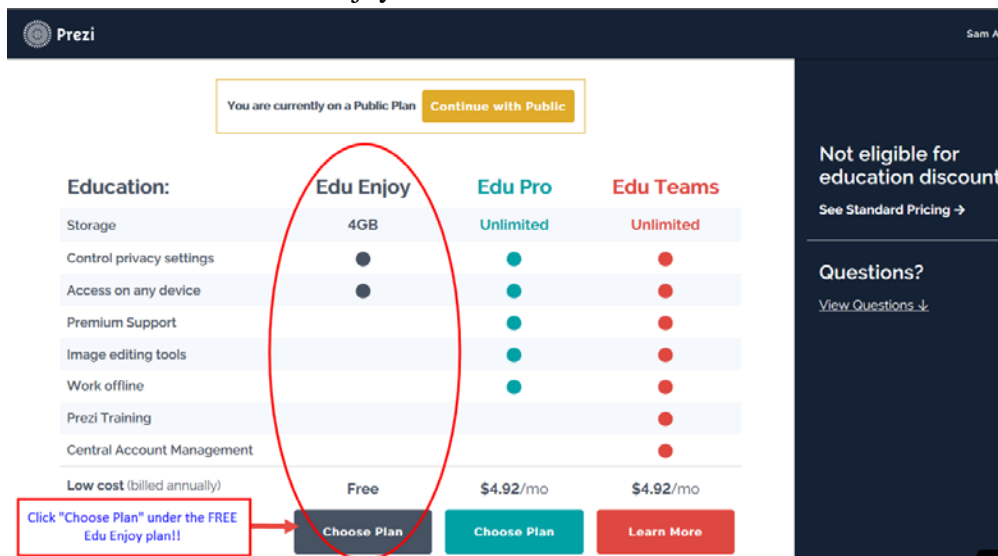
1. Sign into your Prezi account.

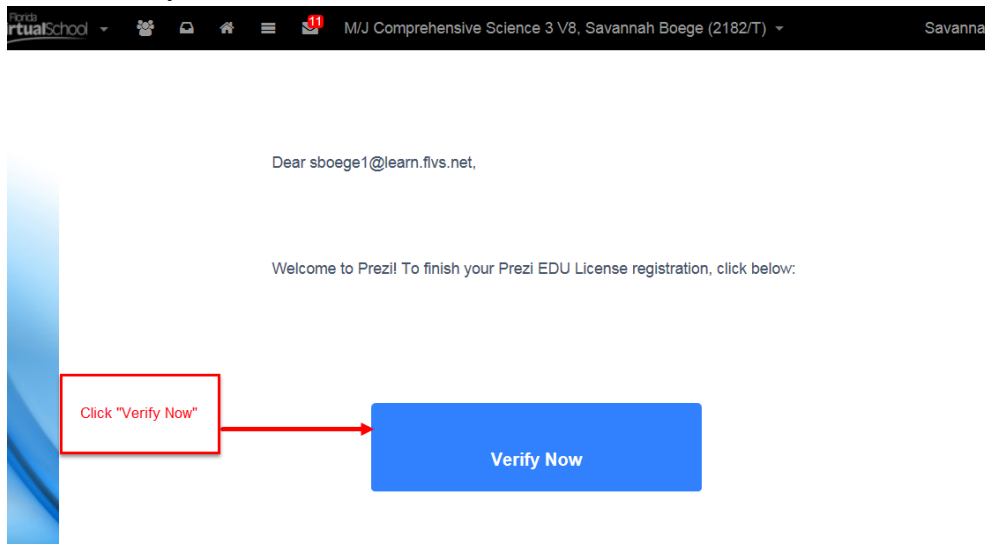

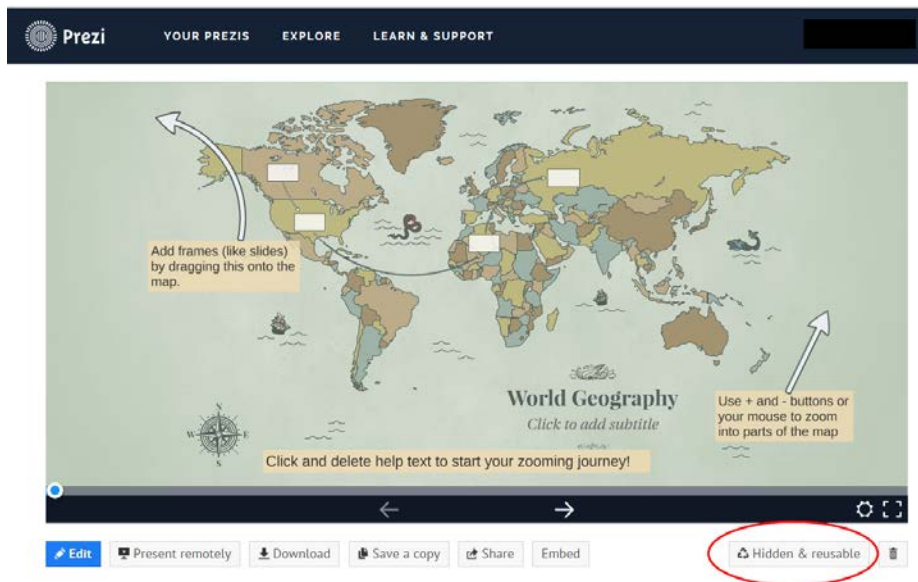

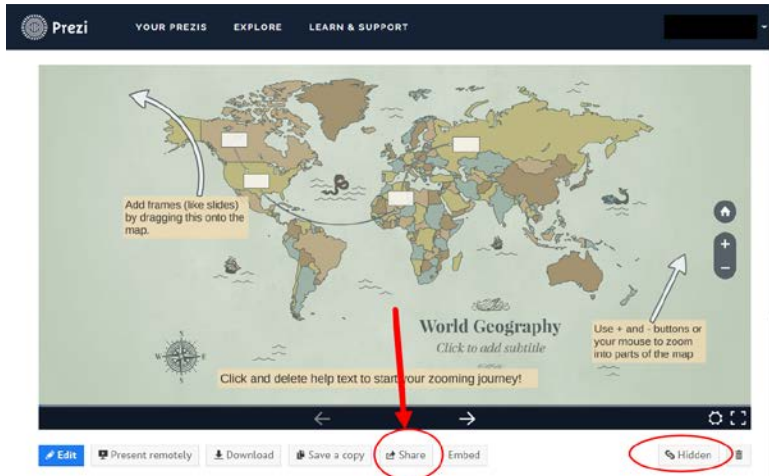
